Photographs should be in digital form with at least of 5 mega pixels size. Each participant can submit a maximum of 3 entries.

Prize and term of references

- The last date of receiving entries in the institute is **1**st **September 2019**.
- Best entry (judged by a panel of external referees) in each thematic area will be given a token incentive (Ist prize Rs. 10,000.00; IInd Rs. 5,000.00; and one consolation prize Rs. 2,000.00) and a certificate of merit.
