



# **Forest-based Resources** and **Livelihood Options**









### Background

Nearly 1.6 billion people (25%), including 60 million indigenous people, depend on forests for subsistence, livelihood, employment, and income generation. In India, around 275 million people, coming to around 40% of the country's poor population, live in the forest fringes and depend on the forest for their livelihood. Forest in Uttarakhand spread over 34650 km<sup>2</sup> where indigenous communities gather multiple resources to support their living and livelihoods. Mapping resources and availability are crucial for long-term conservation, sustainable utilization, and community livelihoods.

### **Objectives**

- To deliberate on the current state of knowledge on forest-based resources in the Indian Himalayan region focusing on Uttarakhand
- To understand the role of forest resources in the income and livelihood
- To develop strategies for harnessing forest resources as a source of sustainable livelihood and for their conservation and management





### Deliverables

The envisaged outcome of the workshop will be 'Workshop Proceedings' and key messages, which will form the report on the "current state of knowledge on forest-based resources and their role in providing livelihood to the indigenous communities.
