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Call for Articles in the next issue of EIACP Bulletin on Harmony with Nature in the Mountainous Landscapes with a Special Focus on the Himalayas & Ending Plastic Pollution, Volume 33, 2025

The EIACP Bulletin invites contributions for articles under two critical themes: "Harmony with Nature in the Mountainous Landscapes with a Special Focus on the Himalayas" and "Ending Plastic Pollution." The Himalayan region, known for its unique biodiversity and cultural significance, faces numerous environmental challenges.

Articles are sought that explore how communities in these mountainous landscapes can harmonize with nature through sustainable practices. Subthemes include *restoring native biodiversity, sustainable agriculture and livelihoods, water resource management, traditional ecological knowledge, climate resilience, and the preservation of sacred landscapes and cultural heritage*. By integrating these practices, the region can continue to thrive while maintaining ecological balance. In parallel, "Ending Plastic Pollution" addresses one of the most urgent global environmental crises. Articles under this theme should explore strategies for reducing plastic waste and its adverse effects on ecosystems and human health. Key subthemes include *reducing single-use plastics, developing sustainable waste management systems, promoting eco-friendly tourism and trekking, fostering community-led clean-up initiatives, and the role of policy, education, and awareness in mitigating plastic pollution*. Together, these themes offer an opportunity to examine innovative solutions and traditional knowledge that can drive positive environmental change.

We invite scholars, researchers, and practitioners to submit full length articles (3500-4000 words and less than 15 references) in Hindi or English, including supporting figures, data, and case studies, for publication.
